Demonstrate your swimming ability in accordance to the Red Cross Aqua Quest level 11, OR

2. Complete all of the following: a) Tread water in deep water, for a minimum of four (4) minutes.

b) Front crawl for 100 metres. c) Back crawl for 100 metres d) Elementary backstroke for 50 metres

e) Breaststroke for 50 metres f) Sidestroke for 50 metres g) Butterfly stroke, 3 x 10 metres

h) Endurance swim for 400 metres continuously, using any stroke or combination of strokes.

Why? A competition camp for youth to demonstrate their camping, outdoor and teamwork skills that they have learned. The youth will be doing this without the assistance of their leaders.

When? 7:00pm Friday April 20, to 12:00pm Sunday April 22, 2012

Where? Camp Manitou – 7484 Twiss Road, Burlington ON <http://campmanitou.scouter.ca/>

Cost? \$10 per youth, \$8 per Leader (we will have to add our food, transport costs)

Theme? *ROMAN vs GREEK*

THE CHARIOT – We build it, bring it to camp, then race it!

Hello all! This year as you may know we are going back to ancient Greece and Rome! There will be a lot of adventure during the weekend and you'll need to travel in style. You will be required to build and bring your very own chariot. Of course you will be following our guide lines and will be judged on the structure, safety and design of your creation.

***Remember when building, your chariot must**

-Seat 2 people (the passengers will be randomly chosen at camp)

-carry eggbert at all times (an egg we adopt for the weekend)

-Minimum length of 120 cm -minimum width of 60 cm -minimum height of 45 cm (from base)

-Minimum 2 wheels -realistic but creative

Your group must work together to transport the chariot and passengers along the camp paths. As well please supply head protect (Bike Helmets!) for *the all riders*.

NOTE – we will be judged on our Scout Craft! So, we need to brush up on our lashing skills.
